

# Failure to Certify Notification to Persons Served by Known or Potential Service Line Containing Lead

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

### Reporting Requirements Not Met for GA0770004 TURIN

We were required to demonstrate to the State that we provided initial notification to all persons at a Lead, Galvanized Requiring Replacement (GRR), or Lead Status Unknown water service line.

Our system failed to demonstrate to the State that we delivered annual notifications and information to people served by the water system at a Lead, Galvanized Requiring Replacement, or Lead Status Unknown service line as required by July 1, 2025; or we failed to meet the prescribed timing, delivery, and/or content requirements. Although the failure to comply with the reporting requirement does not create a risk to public health, we are required to inform you of this violation and provide additional information including what we did to correct the situation.

It is important for consumers to know if the water they are receiving has been delivered through a Lead, Galvanized Requiring Replacement, or Lead Status Unknown service line so they can make decisions on taking actions to reduce their potential exposure to lead in their drinking water.

### What Should You Do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. You do NOT need to boil your water or take other actions. Boiling water does NOT remove lead from water.
