NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE**

The Town of Turin is establishing a 2022 millage rate of 1.5 mills, which will generate an estimated \$51,760 in property tax.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on this tax increase to be held at Town Hall, 47 Turin Rd. Turin GA 30289 on August 15, at 10:30 a.m. and 6:30 p.m.

Time and place of additional public hearing on this tax increase is at Town Hall, 47 Turin Rd. Turin GA 30289 on August 24th at 10:30 a.m. with a Special Called Meeting to follow.

The tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 1.5 mills, an increase of 1.5 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 0 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$300,000 is approximately \$180.00.

- Nancy Smith wanted to know what Council was going to do with the monies. Mayor Starr advised her that the Town would be using these monies for road maintenance and repairs. Would like the monies to go towards sewage for down town.
- Patrick Fulford wanted to know if some of the monies would be used to widen certain roads to normal width.
